- d. <u>Greystar Permit Fees:</u> Authorize the Chairman of the Mount Joy Township Board of Supervisors to execute an agreement stating the fee for Zoning permit applications for the Greystar apartment complex along S. Conifer Drive will be assessed at 0.125% of the construction cost per permit.
- e. <u>Old Trolley Line Park Grant:</u> Adopt a resolution whereby, upon adoption, the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors is authorized to sign the grant application that is being submitted for Old Trolley Line Park Phase 3.
